






Binani Science Complex




Academic Year




















The Schedule

Admission Procedure

Nurrsery to H.K.G.

The minimum age for admission in nursery is 2½ years and in L.K.G. is 3½ years. The child should be able to communicate in Hindi/English. Admission will be on the basis of an interaction with students and parents. Parents should submit Date of Birth Certificate with 4 coloured photographs of student along with Aadhar Card.

Class 1" to 12"

Admission based on personal interaction. For class 1st and above the student is required to bring the T.C. & Marksheet of the previous Institution with 4 coloured photographs of student along with Aadhar Card.

Annual Fee : It is payable once in a year.


Tution Fee : It is payable quarterly. (Fee has to be deposited before 15th of the month)
